Our Musical Journey today celebrates the "Hers of Hymn" writers featuring Miss Fanny Crosby. 1820-1915 Fanny Crosby, born in New York, dubbed the "American Hymn Queen" lost her sight at 6 weeks of age from maltreatment during a sick spell. Blindness did not stop her from obtaining an education and becoming a teacher of grammar, rhetoric and American History. Fanny wrote

words to many song styles before writing words for hymns at age 40 for a local publisher. Men and women would bring their melodies to Fanny, play them for her and ask, "What does this melody say"? After a few minutes Fanny would give a name and oft times write the words within 30 minutes. She wrote over **8,000** hymns in her lifetime. Earning enough money to live well, she chose to live in a small simple house with her husband near one of Manhattan's notorious slums (The Bowery) and was zealous in her efforts to help the people around her. Her words still inspire composers today. *Next week our Musical Journey will feature early church leaders and Ministers; Martin Luther, Charles Wesley and Robert Robinson.*
