Martin Luther, 1483-1546, was an Augustinian Monk/Priest/Professor and became a church reformer. He had a great influence on hymn writing (setting the standard) and wrote over 500 hymns.



Isaac Watts, 1674-1748, was an English Minister of the Independent Church and a respected Nonconformist. A fever shattered his health resulting in his early retirement, but he continued his ministerial duties as much as he could. He wrote 1980 hymns and many religious books during the latter part of his life.



Charles Wesley, 1707-1788, was an English leader of the Methodist movement and was sent as a Missionary to the thirteenth American Colony in Georgia. He is most widely known for writing over 6500 hymns of the highest quality which even now stand the test of time.



Robert Robinson, 1726-1791, was an English Baptist Minister whose call was "to supply the pulpit". He was invited to enter the ministry of the Church of England, but he never changed his Nonconformist ways and persuaded members to incorporate "open communion". He wrote many books, including "The History of Baptism and Baptists" and 24 hymns.
